## The Virge

*Virga (Virge)* in the classical world:  
VERGIL

The *virga*, “stick” or “wand”, was a crucial talisman for Aeneas when he visited the Underworld. As described in Book VI of Vergil's *Aeneid*, he has been advised to visit the spirit of his deceased father Anchises. If he were unable to penetrate beneath earth's secrets, he could not found Rome.

In the first passage, the Sibyl, prophetess of Apollo, tells Aeneas that he must acquire a golden *virga* before visiting the underworld:

But no one is granted permission to penetrate the earth's secrets before he has plucked from the tree the golden-leaved offshoot.

This as her own gift beautiful Proserpina has resolved be brought to her. When the first branch is torn away, a second golden one springs forth, sprouting with the same metallic hue.

And so [Aeneas] look high with your eyes. Duly find it and seize it by hand. For of its own accord easily it will yield, if the Fates so call you. Otherwise you will not be able to overcome it with any strength, nor tear it off with harsh steel.

(*Aeneid* 6.141-149)

Charon, the grizzled ferryman who takes spirits across the River Styx, agrees to take Aeneas only after he sees the golden *virga*:

Then his boiling anger receded in his heart.

He, saying no more, marveled at the awe-inspiring gift of the fateful branch seen so long a time.

He turned his dark boat and approached the shore.

(*Aeneid* 6.408-410)
